Expansion, Renovation, and Realignment of Outpatient Clinical Services

- Renovating and expanding the existing clinics
- Relocating from a one-story, leased outpatient clinic to a newly constructed five-story, hospital-owned outpatient. Center, and backfilling the leased space with additional clinical services.
- Transition from a private physician practice to a hospital-based outpatient clinic.
- Provision of uninterrupted patient services during renovations.
